

# LensCoat<sup>®</sup> Canon 100-400 IS II INSTRUCTIONS

# Piece 1- Lens Hood Cover

Remove the lens hood cover from the lens. Carefully slide and stretch the lens cover into place.

### Piece 2

Remove rotating collar foot for easier placement of piece 2-4, stretch and slide piece 2 down the lens to the zoom ring.

### Piece 3

Slide piece 3 down the lens to the zoom tension ring.

### Piece 4

Slide piece 4 it down the lens to the focus ring.

### Piece 5

Slide piece 5 on the last segment of the lens lining up the distance window and AF controls. For final placement pull the window for the slightly away from the lens and adjust to the left or right.

# Optional Pieces for when not using lens foot-

### Piece 4b

If you are not using the lens foot you can slide piece 4b over the rotating collar lining up the hole with the rotating collar knob and use piece 5 as instructed above

# Piece 5b

If you are not using the lens foot tighten the rotating collar after you align the line on the collar with the red alignment mark then you can slide piece 5b over the rotating collar lining up the hole with the rotating collar knob and the windows. This piece is used instead of Piece 5.

# **Rotating Lens Collar**

The LensCoat<sup>®</sup> Canon 100-400 IS II lens cover kit includes a strip of neoprene with adhesive tape applied to the back for the rotating lens collar if you are not using parts 4b or 5b. Cutout the desired length for the parts of the lens collar you want to cover. Cut the longest piece first. After all the cutting is done then remove the adhesive tape backing by carefully folding back a small corner and apply to the lens collar.

# Zoomed Lens Barrel

The LensCoat<sup>®</sup> Canon 100-400 IS II lens cover kit includes an optional piece that can be affixed to the lens via the Velcro strip used only when the lens is fully extended
